





















#### Mark 12:1-10

"At the harvest time he sent a slave to the vine-growers, in order to receive some of the produce of the vineyard from the vinegrowers. "They took him, and beat him and sent him away empty-handed. "Again he sent them another slave, and they wounded him in the head, and treated him shamefully. "And he sent another, and that one they killed; and so with many others, beating some and killing others. .....
